They will use marking kits from BikeRegister that consist of two tamper-resistant labels (see image) which are placed on the frame of the bike. The bike will then be registered on the BikeRegister national cycle database using the unique code on the label, along with the bike frame no. The database is used by every Police force in the UK to help reunite owners with their stolen bikes.
